Adelaide to Perth

across the

Nullarbor

2,750 km **Distance**

Best Time to Travel May to September is most comfortable / nights can be cool Summer generally has hot days/cold nights

Suggest Time Frame for Travel

14 days minimum (longer if you'd like to explore South Western Australia and/or

start in Melbourne)

Highlights

Sealed road – perfect to travel in a 2WD camper

Time your visit from May to September to see the Southern Right Whales playing in the Great Australian Bight

You'll be amazed how close you can get to the **Bunda Cliffs**, particularly on the South Australian side of the Nullarbor Plain

- If you have a love of **seafood**, travel the **Eyre Peninsular**, or at a minimum stop in **Ceduna** for some fresh **oysters** (add an extra 3 days min for the Eyre Peninsular)
- Plenty of opportunity to see wildlife like kangaroos, camels, wombats and emus
- Western Australia is world renowned for having one of the most spectacular displays of wildflowers in the world. Time your visit from around late August to November to see the brilliant blaze of colour
 - Stop in at local information centres for a brochure on the many 'wildflower' touring routes in South Western Australia (including inland)
- There are some **freedom camps** (free or low cost camping) as well as a commercial camps crossing the Nullarbor, and a number around the Eyre Peninsular and in WA.
- Grab a Holiday National Park Pass in WA to save money on entry fees
