

Aboriginal culture and rock art along with a variety of wildlife is all part of the Kakadu experience. (cruise incl)
- Stay on a working cattle station in the NT with a **4WD Sunset Tour and BBQ dinner** (inc)
- Visit Litchfield National Park with its range of walks, swimming spots and giant termite mounds
- Check out the **Jumping Crocs** (incl) and beautiful **wetlands** teeming with birdlife
- Enjoy a morning cruise up the famous **Katherine Gorge** (cruise incl)
- Soak in the Thermal Springs at Mataranka

To give you as much flexibility as possible, we have not included any paid attractions in Broome, as some like to do the Horizontal Falls. This is costly and not for everyone and will need to be pre-booked. There are also a large range of other flights, fishing trips, 4WD trips and the Pearl Farm tour. We'll provide separate details on the Broome attractions and would highly recommend pre-booking to avoid disappointment. We feel this gives you the greatest flexibility and value for money we do include one of the must-do's in Broome, which is **sundowners at Cable Beach.**
- We've included **Karijini National Park** tour so you can see the beauty of these **deep red gorges** that are hidden away on an unsealed road, plus check out the **iron ore mining** in this area (incl)
- Spend time at the world's largest coral fringing reef, the Ningaloo Reef with a glass bottom boat and snorkelling experience as well as a boat cruise at Yardie Creek (incl). Plenty of time to relax and swim/snorkel in the Ningallo reef, or wander around the Cape Range National Park
- Enjoy a cruise at **Monkey Mia** to see a **Pearl Farm** and wildlife spotting including the **sponge dolphin** and maybe even a **Dugong!** (incl)
- Before arriving in Perth travel along the stunning coastline and **turquoise waters** of WA stopping to explore the blaze of colour from the **wildflowers**, Kalbarri National Park, the Pinnacles and the interesting coastal towns
- Learn more about **WWII history** and experience the vibrant multicultural city of Darwin (we suggest adding on an extra couple of days at the start of your holiday to see more of Darwin City from a city hotel or getting your camper early; subject to availability)
- The tour ends in Perth, a beautiful city on the banks of the Swan River, surrounded by sandy beaches you may like to add on a day or two here too
