

- Explore the Brisbane hinterland with a rainforest walk at Mount Glorious or spectacular coastal views from the Glasshouse Mountains then enjoy a relaxed group welcome dinner at camp, in the small country town of Esk
- Cross the **Great Dividing Range** into the fertile **Darling Downs**, one of Queensland's most important farming regions. Visit the charming rural city of **Toowoomba**, the 'Garden City'. Enjoy bushwalks, tour the WWII bunkers and a social campfire at beautiful **Possum Park**
- Visit Roma, home to the largest livestock saleyards in Australia! Learn about the area at the Oil Patch museum and take a tour of the historical stained-glass windows of St Paul's church
- Enter the great **Queensland outback** and discover its remote beauty, wide open spaces and a sky that stretches to the horizon
- Relax in the therapeutic waters of the Great Artesian Spa
- Have a fun night at outback Queensland station, **Bonus Downs**. We've lined up a station tour which includes a visit to the ancient **Ooline trees** located on this property.
- Visit Australia's last remaining steam driven Woolscour at Blackall and see hot water coming straight out of the ground
- Jump on board a Cobb & Co Stagecoach for a gallop along part of the old mail route just like in the pioneer days
- Entry included into the award winning Stockman's Hall of Fame at Longreach, with outback show, to give you an understanding of the rich history of the outback life
- Experience Winton, the quirky outback town where 'Waltzing Matilda' was penned. Be amazed by the incredible Australian Age of Dinosaur
- Discover more about the famed and spooky **Min Min Lights** near the very remote outback pub at Middleton. A remnant of a bygone era, you'll enjoy a meal with some real **outback characters**
- Mining town, **Mt Isa** will come alive with a visit into the award winning **Hard Times Underground Mine** and tour of an **underground hospital**
- Learn more about the droving era at the Camooweal Drovers Camp
- Spend a fun evening at the famous outback pub at Daly Waters with entertainment and a delicious beef 'n barra dinner
- Enjoy a relaxing soak in the thermal springs at Mataranka and a cruise up the famous Katherine Gorge
- Take a magical **dawn cruise** at **Yellow Water** in World Heritage listed **Kakadu National Park's** most famous wetland, with abundant birdlife and the big 'salties' (crocs) a sight to remember! **Aboriginal culture and rock art** with a huge diversity of wildlife is all part of the Kakadu experience
- Lots of opportunity to check out the **beautiful wetlands** that will be teeming with birds at this time of the year
- Visit breathtaking Litchfield National Park with its range of walks, swimming spots and giant termite mounds
- Arrive in **Darwin**, former frontier outpost and now **vibrant multicultural city** steeped in **WWII history** (we suggest adding on an extra couple of days to see more of Darwin from a city hotel or keep your motorhome - must be pre-booked)
- To start and finish this amazing journey on a high, we include **dinner** on these nights. We also love the camaraderie our tours offer, so we have regular **group meals/happy hours** along the way too!
