Conditions for Campervan & Motorhome Rental (Australia)

Valid 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024

Summary of Rental Conditions

This document contains a brief summary of our rental conditions. The full details of the rental contract do apply. Rates quoted are in Australian dollars.

Kitchen Kit: plates, bowls, knives, forks, spoons, bottle opener, can opener, mixing bowls, colander, saucepans, frying pans, cooking utensils, chopping board, kettle, teapot, toaster and tea towel. Electrical appliances are supplied in vehicles that have 240V.

General Equipment: pegs, clothesline, fire extinguisher, bucket, hose, broom, dustpan and brush. 4WD RVs also include a Personal Locator Beacon.

Personal Kit: complimentary bedding (including sheets, blankets, pillows, pillowcases and towels).

Drop and Go: simply return the vehicle neat and tidy and we'll take care of the rest including vehicle, cabin and bathroom cleaning (this does not include emptying the toilet cassette and the grey water tank).

Online Check-In

It is mandatory for guests to complete Apollo's online check in prior to pick up at <https://preregistration.apollocamper.com/>

By completing the required pick-up information ahead of the pick-up date, guests will experience a smoother and quicker RV collection process. Guests will also be required to watch our Apollo safe driving video prior to pick up, and can access our 'How To Videos' through the Apollo Connect App prior to pick up to learn how to use their RV.

Rate Exclusions

We're cooking with gas! A gas bottle is necessary for cooking in the RV. A full gas bottle(s) may be pre-purchased and can be returned empty to Apollo at the completion of the road trip. Fee applies for each booking of a multiple rental.

Gas bottles for the compact RVs (such as Hi-top, Endeavour and 2BTS) and 4WD RVs cost \$25. Gas bottles for the 4 Berth and 6 Berth RVs cost \$35.

Long Hire Discount

21+ days - 8% off daily rates

- These discounts do not apply to the 'value pack' Component of the rental
- Multiple rentals are eligible for the long-term discount (if total exceeds 21 days)
- There are no further long-term discounts available on rates

Early Bird Discount

An Early Bird Discount of 5% off the daily rental rate will apply to rentals that commence 180 days after the date of booking. This discount does not apply to the 'value pack' component. The Early Bird discount can be combined with long term discounts.

Multiple Rentals

Should a customer have more than one consecutive rental they can be combined to qualify for longer-term discounts of the daily vehicle rates. Details are on application.

Rental Charges

Rentals are charged per calendar day. The day of the pick-up is calculated as the first day of rental and the day of return is calculated as the last day of rental. Vehicles must be returned within branch hours.

Standard Rates - When a rental moves from one rate season into the next, the calculation is based on both rates.

Flex Rates - The flex rate that is available at the time of booking for the first rental day determines the daily rental rate for the entire rental period up to the 7th day. All rental days from the 8th day on are counted as a new booking and the flex rate that applies for the 8th day will be used from then on, the flex rate that applies for the 15th rental day will be used from then, etc.

Flex rates resets after 7 days and are based on supply and demand until a confirmed booking has been made.

Flex Rates are completely separate to any other rate or special you may have. Flex Rates do not replace these other rates or specials; rather Flex Rates offer you another choice. Flex Rates only apply to new bookings. **Apollo** will not accept cancellations of any other rate scheme that are then re-booked using Flex Rates or vice versa. Flex Rates cannot be combined with any other rate scheme.

Driver's Licence and Minimum Age

For the safety of our guests a current and full motor vehicle driver licence is required to be shown at pick-up and the driver needs to be present. If the driver licence is not in English, then we require accredited English translation or an International Driver Permit. For travel in the Northern Territory an International Driving Permit is required along with the foreign driver licence. We do not accept Digital Driver Licences.

Note: UK driver licences that have had approved extensions by the UK DVLA (Driver and Vehicle Licencing Agency) can still travel for up to 11 months past the licence expiry. This extension only applies to full GB driving licence holders. It does not apply to provisional driving licence entitlement.

Apollo and **Cheapa Campa** drivers must be over the age of 21, have held a licence for at least two years and the licence must be valid for the entire booking duration.

It is important to provide us with the correct country that your drivers licence has been issued to, to ensure we include any country specific discounts which are available from time to time.

Rate Calculation

Not all rates and terms apply to group bookings (any rental that consists of four or more vehicles travelling together). Requests for convoy bookings should be directed to campers@gallivantingoz.com.au

Booking Alterations

We understand that sometimes plans change. If this is the case, any changes made to a booking will be calculated by using the higher one of two rates, either the original Flex Rate or the Flex Rate current at the time of booking alteration. The following are considered as a booking alteration:

- Change of name
- Change to pick-up or drop-off dates
- Change pick-up or drop-off branch location
- Change of RV category
- Change of rate scheme including special rates

If the rate scheme or RV category is changed, this is considered a new booking and cancellation fees may apply to the original booking.

If there are any last-minute alternations made within 14 days of pick-up, we will be happy to accommodate these depending on availability. However due to the short notice if the holiday is shortened, the number of days originally booked will be charged.

If the pick-up or drop-off location is altered within 14 days of pick up, a change of location fee may also apply.

Change of Drop Off Destination after pick up

If the renter wishes to change the drop off destination after the rental has commenced, they first must obtain authorisation from the Reservations team. Subject to the change being approved, you will be also advised if a relocation fee applies.

Rental Extension while on the road

If you want to extend your booking whilst on the road, you should first contact the Reservations team who will be happy to advise if the extension is possible, and the costs associated. To secure an extension, the extra costs (calculated on the current rate of the day), will need to be paid by credit card inclusive of all taxes and surcharges, either over the phone or at an Apollo Branch at the time of extension. Of course, any long-term discounts in place, will continue to apply to the booking.

We will always do our best to accommodate any extensions however it is subject to availability of our fleet.

Change of RV

We understand guests' needs are different and therefore our RVs can be requested by category, however not by make or model. We always do our best to accommodate requests, however should the RV booked be unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances, we will substitute the booked RV with an alternative available RV at time of pick-up, at no extra cost. Any changes made to the booked RV and agreed to by the guest do not entitle the guest to a refund.

In the event of no alternative RV being available to the guest, Apollo's liability is limited to a refund of the hire charge or in the case of mechanical failure (unless caused by the guest) the remainder of the hire period.

Online Check-In

It is mandatory for guests to complete Apollo's online check-in prior to pick-up at:

By completing the required pick-up information ahead of the pick-up date, guests will experience a smoother and quicker RV collection process. Guests will also be required to watch our Apollo safe driving video prior to pick-up, and can access our 'How To Videos' through the Roadtrip App prior to pick-up to learn how to use their RV. You'll also be reminded about this closer to travelling.

Roadtrip App

The thl Roadtrip App is custom-built app available for guests travelling in Australia and New Zealand. The free app provides guests with all the necessary information needed to make their Apollo journey even better.

The App is designed to:

- Enhance guest's holiday experience by providing 'how-to videos' prior to pick up, so that they become familiar with their vehicle before arriving at the branch, and prepare any questions they may have
- Educate our guests on how to use the vehicle and safe driving practices
- Provide Apollo contact details to extend their holiday, contact roadside assistance, email any other enquiries and find answers to FAQ's
- Provide information on campgrounds while on the road and allow for campgrounds to be booked
- Search and book great deals on attractions and activities through ApolloClub
- Find helpful information on branch locations, nearby petrol stations, dumping stations, supermarkets, ATMs etc

Guests can download the app on **Google Play** or the **App Store**. A link to the online check in and Roadtrip App has been provided with your booking confirmation.

Getting to and from the airport

Branches are conveniently located near major airports, making pick-up and drop-off even easier for our guests. Guests can arrange transport at their own cost to and from the airport via taxi or uber/rideshare at your own cost.

Branch Locations and Vehicle availability

Apollo branches are located across Australia, allowing you to plan for road trips both long and short. Our Broome branch is a little more remote than others and therefore a single \$800 location fee applies to guests who pick-up or drop-off at our Broome branch.

Branch Opening Hours: (allow 1 hour for collection)

The opening hours of our branches vary, depending on location and seasonality. The below table details the specific hours for pick-up and drop-off:

The Broome, Darwin and Alice Springs depots are closed during the wet season (01 December to 31 March). During this time roads are muddy and hard to navigate, for safety reasons we recommend that guests avoid travelling to the top end of Australia during this time.

All branches are closed Good Friday (07 April 2023) Christmas Day (25 December 2023), New Year's Day (01 January 2024), and Observed Australia Day (26 January 2024).

Please ensure you arrive at the depot by 15:00 at the latest for pickup of your vehicle and return by 15:30.

Rental Duration

An RV holiday allows guests to travel at their own pace. To ensure our guests get the most out of their road trip, a minimum five-day booking period applies when pick-up and drop-off is from the same branch location. Higher minimum rental days apply for all brands as follows and are subject to change. Updates with minimum rental periods will be advised through Apollo Announcements.

Additional minimum periods apply as follows:

- 7 Day minimum hire period for Splendour In the Grass Music Festival 20th to 25th July in BNE
- 7 Day minimum hire period for Moto GP 19th to 23rd October 2023 in MEL
- 7 Day minimum hire period 28th March to 2nd April 2024 for Easter
- 7 Day minimum hire period in SYD for 6th to 9th October Bathurst 2023
- 10 Day minimum hire period Christmas 26th Dec 2023 to 4th Jan 2024

One Way Rentals

Road-trips don't always finish where they started, some of the best adventures don't. If a guest drops-off at a different branch location from which they picked-up, a minimum booking period, one-way fees apply as follows:

- Pick up Cairns, Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth and Hobart – returning to these locations a \$175.00 one-way fee applies.
- Pick up Cairns, Brisbane, Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth and Hobart - returning to Darwin, Broome or Alice Springs a \$260.00 one-way fee applies.
- Pick-ups from Darwin, Broome and Alice Springs - returning to any location a \$260.00 one-way fee applies

There are no one way rentals permitted from Hobart to any other location between 1 November and 31 March, unless specific permission is granted by Apollo scheduling.

Additional minimum periods apply as follows:

- 20 Days minimum hire on all O/W rentals INTO CNS (excluding 4WDs) from 12th Jan - 30th Aug 2023
- 20 Days minimum hire on all O/W rentals OUT of ASP, DRW from 1 Apr - 10th July 2023 excl to ASP, DRW (excl 4wd's)
- 30 Days minimum hire on all O/W rentals IN to HBT from 1st Mar to 30th July 2023
- 30 day minimum hire on all O/W rentals INTO ASP, DRW, BME from 1st July - 30th Nov 2023 excl FROM ASP, BME & DRW (excl 4wd's)
- 30 Days minimum hire on all O/W rentals OUT of HBT from 1st August 2023 to 1st February 2024

Travel Restrictions

Not all RVs are suitable for all driving situations, so it's important the right RV is chosen for the travel planned. Apollo, at its discretion may restrict RV travel in certain areas due to adverse road or weather conditions, and the distance to nominated destinations in relation to the length of the rental period. If applicable, any further restrictions will be mentioned at pickup.

Once on the road, guests are encouraged to contact the roadside team, Apollo Assist on 1300 798 212 if they have any concerns regarding road accessibility. For the safety of guests, the following travel restrictions are in place:

Guests who travel to restricted areas without permission will void all liability cover in the event of damage or accident and may be subject to a penalty fee of \$300 charged on each occasion identified.

2WD RVs

Our 2WD RVs aren't equipped for the rougher terrain and cannot be driven on unsealed roads. Well maintained access roads which lead to recognised campgrounds and are less than 10 kilometres long are allowed.

Apollo 2WD RVs can be driven to any island on sealed roads as long as permission is obtained from Apollo Assist prior to travel.

4WD RVs

Our 4WD RVs are ready to take adventurous travellers off the beaten track, however for the safety of our guests, there are areas from which our vehicles are restricted. For restricted destinations listed below, guests are required to nominate expected travel plans with the branch at pick-up and confirm with relevant local authorities that roads are passable prior to travel.

**Travel to Cape York is not permitted between the period of 1 December to 31 May and at all other times, written permission is required*

Apollo at its discretion may restrict RV travel in certain areas due to adverse road or weather conditions, and the distance to nominated destinations in relation to the length of the rental period. If applicable, any further restrictions will be mentioned at pick-up. Guests are encouraged to contact Apollo Assist at 1300 798 212 if any concerns regarding road accessibility.

4WD restricted maps have also been provided – please request another copy if you do not have.

Kilometres

For the safety of guests please don't underestimate the time it will take to get from one point to another. While our 2WD RVs include unlimited kilometres we recommend travelling a maximum of 250 kilometres per day or the equivalent of 4-5 hours driving. We encourage our guests to take a break from driving at least every 2 hours.

Our 4WD rates include 300 kilometres per day however should a little more adventure be needed, 500-kilometre packages are available before or at time of pick-up for AU\$240. If the road travelled is a little longer, any excess kilometres will be charged at \$0.40 per kilometre payable on return. The 4WD additional cover package includes unlimited kilometres.

Returning the RV

The RV is a home away from home and for comfort, we recommend it's kept tidy throughout the road trip. The RVs need to be returned to the branch as they were taken, with the interior cleaned, the toilet cassette emptied (where applicable) and holding tanks emptied. The RV exterior does not require cleaning unless it's covered with excessive dirt or mud, making it difficult for our team to see its return condition. Drop and Go is available to be pre-purchased or added on pick-up to offer quick and easy return.

Repairs

We understand that while on holiday the RV may require small repairs. So not to disrupt the road trip any further, if the damage was not caused by the guest, repairs up to \$100 can be completed without authorisation and will be reimbursed

upon presentation of receipts. If repairs over \$100 are needed, the Apollo Assist team should be informed prior to repair being completed. Unauthorised repairs are not permitted.

All RVs are enrolled in the Australian Automobile Association and 24hr mechanical emergency roadside assistance is available if needed. Please contact Apollo Assist at 1300 798 212 for on road care.

Infringements, Tolls and Fines

Apollo will pass on any charges the guest receives for traffic infringements, toll way or parking fines during your road trip. For toll way fees received, Apollo reserves the right to charge the guests credit or debit card upon receiving the toll way fee. An administration fee of AU\$75 to cover associated administrative costs per toll way fee, traffic infringement or parking fine received may be charged.

Animals

We believe fur friends can only make a road trip better and both service animals and pet dogs are allowed to travel in Apollo and Cheapa Campa vehicles with written permission from Apollo at time of booking. There is a \$250 pet fee (excludes service animals). Please ask to find out more regarding the policy regarding this. Service dogs are permitted in all vehicles. If a vehicle is returned soiled by a pet, Apollo reserves the right to charge and extra cleaning fee. Please ask to see the full policy or can be viewed on the website.

Smoking and Drugs

Our RVs are a smoke free and drug free zone; hence smoking or drugs are not permitted in any of our RVs. If smoke or drug residue is detected Apollo reserves the right to charge a cleaning fee.

Ferry Reservations

Ferry reservations can be difficult to manage during the high season. We recommend that a reservation is made for a 7.7m vehicle on the ferry, irrespective as to the size of the campervan reserved, to avoid complications due to possible upgrades.

Payments at Branches

For security reasons, the depots do not accept cash at the branches. They accept credit card and debit card for charges paid on RV pick-up and drop-off. The Bond is payable at pick-up by credit card or debit card and cannot be paid with a pre-paid credit card or cash.

Credit Cards

We only accept Visa and Master card for payment of the deposit. The following fees apply (irrespective of the account chosen e.g. savings, credit, etc):

Travel Insurance

For peace of mind, we strongly recommend that clients ensure they take out the highest level of private Travel Insurance.

PROTECTION PACKAGE

Personal Injury

The RV has third party insurance cover and it is likely that any other vehicle involved in an accident also has third-party insurance. Depending on the circumstances of an accident, the guest may be entitled to claim for their personal injury against the third-party insurance of the party responsible for the accident. The extent of such third-party insurance varies in different States and Territories and Apollo strongly recommends that all passengers take out their own Personal Injury Travel Insurance.

Property Damage

The RV is insured for damage to it and damage to the property of a third party. However, the guest is responsible up to the amount of the applicable liability for damage to third party property, or to the RV. The guest is also responsible for the cost of the daily rate for the period the vehicle is being repaired. There is no refund for unused portion of the rental period. The Liability applies to each claim, not RV.

The liability is applicable regardless of who is at fault and must be paid at the time the accident is reported to Apollo by telephone on a credit card, not on return of the RV. Apollo reserves the right to charge the guest for any RV damage including Third Party property damage not reported but identified on return of the RV.

Liability Options

For peace of mind on the road we offer a range of Liability Options for guests. Guests can choose between the following options:

- ‘Low Road’ – our most basic level of liability cover.
- ‘The Middle Road’ to bring that level down.
- ‘High Road’ our highest cover option – included in the Value Pack.

The amount payable for each Liability Option is based on the number of days of hire minimum rental period applicable for each RV or total days of the RV booking. The maximum charge for Liability Options is 50 days per rental segment.

- Please see terms and conditions for exclusions. The **‘Value Package’** provides excellent peace of mind and value for money (see over page)
- Overhead/underbody damage are excluded from cover under the high road, but are included in the **Apollo** and **Cheapa Campa** Value Pack
- Tyre and Windscreen damage are excluded from the high road cover but are included in the **Apollo** Value Pack (or renter can purchase WAP)
- Single Vehicle Rollover damage excluded from the High Road Cover but included in the Value Pack for **Apollo**, or renter can has purchased Single Vehicle Rollover cover with **Cheapa Campa**

Bond

The bond payment will depend on the liability option chosen. If the guest chooses to take 'The Low Road' or 'The Middle Road', where the bond is a 'charge' the total bond will be debited to the Credit or Visa/Mastercard Debit card immediately (pre-paid credit cards and cash not accepted).

If the guest chooses to take 'The High Road' (imprint) the Bond is payable to Apollo by an open signed credit card imprint with an authorisation for \$250/\$500. The credit card holder must be present to sign for the Bond when they pick-up the RV and is liable for any damage to the RV.

The Bond is fully refundable provided terms are met. The RV simply needs to be returned to the booked Apollo branch location, on time, full of fuel and with the toilet cassette and grey water tank emptied. Credit card refunds (including bond refunds) can take up to 14 business days depending on the guest's financial institution.

If there is damage to the RV on its return or any other terms of the rental contract have not been met, the Bond will be used to cover the cost up to the amount of the relevant Liability. If the terms of the Rental Contract are not met and the Bond is not sufficient to cover the damage, extra costs will be charged.

If a guest is continuing on with another Apollo RV booking, the Bond can be transferred to the next booking within Australia.

Exchange Rate / Currency Variations
